Often leaving consumers to overpay for a less than satisfactory job and unsure who to trust.</p> <p>Here are three things to look for when searching for a qualified dealer:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Consistency and Easy Access If you are looking for a reputable dealer, it's essential they are consistent. Consider, are they using the same logo and company branding? All contact information and addresses should be the same. You should be able to call or email the company with ease. A Reasonable Quote The most common way scammers reach consumers is by providing a quote that is too good to be true. Qualified door dealers outline a quote that is consistent with the problem and will include the necessary labor and costs. If you want to ensure your quote is good, call the company and ask to review the quote with a subperson. Expectations are Made Scammers often show up without identification of the company they work for and even impersonate companies at times. A reputable dealer will detail who to expect and provide proper identification. Most will show up wearing their company logo on their shirt, hat, or even their vehicle.
